Area based development project that push forwards the economics and social development under Thailand 4.0 and accelerate Thailand towards becoming a developed country


- EEC is the first area based development project that has its own mission, law, organization, and systematically economics and social development plan. EEC is an example for other future area development.

- Any other targeted industries that are approved and announced by the EEC Policy Committee



Conduct the Investment Plan and submit to EEC Office for consideration



EECINFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

UNDER PPP FAST TRACK PROGRAM

EEC Policy Committee approved Public-Private-Participation (PPP)-EEC Fast Track without Reducing Steps on 6 July 2017, aims to speed up launch of investment projects, will shorten the time frame to 8-10 months from the current average of 40 months, by eliminating unnecessary procedures and accelerating the entire process.

The PPP EEC TRACK system follows five requirements ("5Cs"), which are certainty, consolidation, concurrence, checks & balances and commitment.

6 development projects under PPP Fast track have been approved by EEC Policy Committee;

- 1. U-Tapao Airport Development and Eastern Aviation City
- 2. High-speed train connecting three airports (Don Muang Suvarnabhumi U-Tapao)
- 3. Maptaphut Industrial Terminal phase 3
- 4. Laem Chabang Deep Sea Port phase 3
- 5. Thai-Airbus Maintenance Repair Overhaul (MRO) Centre
- 6. The development of the Eastern Economic Corridor of Digital Park (EECd)



INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

EEC focuses on transport infrastructure development, a seamless linkage of sea-air-rail transportation and logistic links enhancing regional and global connectivity. Making EEC the most completed transportation and logistic hub in the region, in order to facilitate flourishing economic and investment

Air transport development plan, including the modernization of U-Tapao Airport, first phase towards Aerotropolis, Eastern Aviation City, Aircraft Repair and Maintenance Center

activities, going forward.

High-speed rail links, connecting 3 main international airports: Don Muang, Suvarnabhumi and U-Tapao, for greater convenience, reduced travel time and saving costs.

Double-track rail lines, connecting industrial zone nationwide [China, Laos, Cambodia], also connects to Laem Chabang, Maptaphut Industrial Terminal, Sattahip Deep seaport.

By expanding and developing the transportation and logistic system, the new facilities will be a comprehensive business center for trade, investment, and the most fascinating tourist attraction
